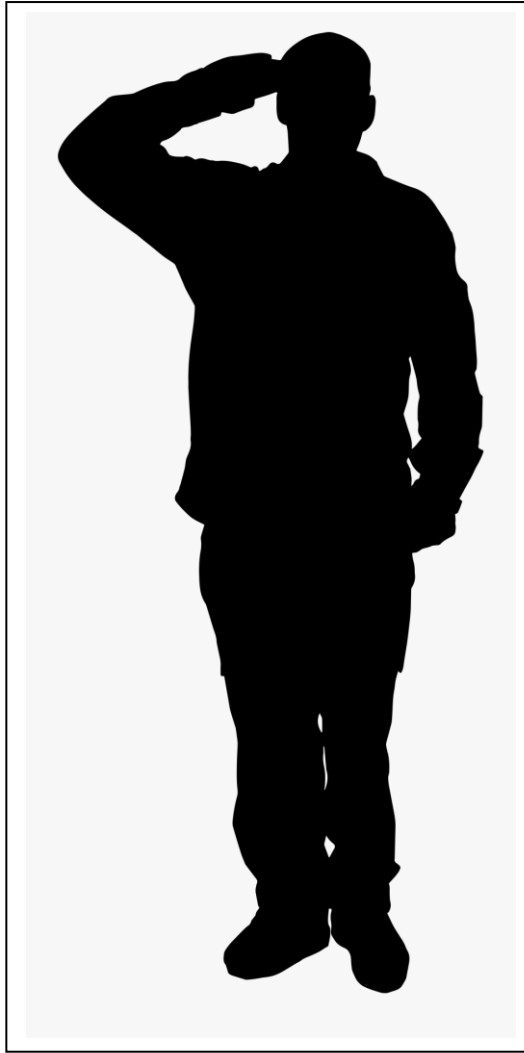


# Combat Stress 100
