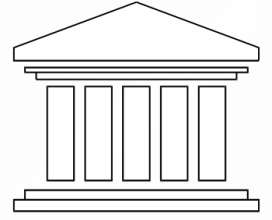

- Morden Regeneration - although current market uncertainties may result in delays to its eventual implementation, we support every effort to transform Morden and will continue to keep a close eye on any development, which should be at human scale and allow for those wishing to downsize.
- Merton Park suburbs – we defend the green, open character of our area and protect it against unneighbourly developments. We shall work to ensure Merton Park is included with restrictions on Houses in Multiple Occupation.
- Proper funding should be found for essential maintenance and improvement in the ward – it was only through MPWRA campaigning and a special grant application that we achieved a water supply in Kendor Gardens!
- We will work to ensure that you have value for money for your Council Tax.
- The quality of our pavements affects wheelchair users and childrens buggies equally and needs as much focus as streets.
- We shall continue our good working relationship with our local police team and ensure they are aware of local challenges.
